Breakfast and Lunch Charge Policy
March-May

The GISD charge policy currently allows students to charge breakfast and lunch until they accumulate \$15.00 worth of charges. GISD normally stops students from charging at the beginning of May, however, each year at the end of school GISD is left with a large amount of unpaid charges. In an effort to reduce the total amount of charges by the end of school, GISD will implement the following plan:

March 11: the total amount a student or employee can charge is reduced to \$10.00.

April 15: the total amount a student or employee can charge is reduced to \$5.00.

May 6: students and employees may no longer charge for the remainder of the school year.

Students who maximize their lunch balance (\$15.00, \$10.00, or \$5.00) will no longer be allowed to charge, however, they may pay cash for their meals or be served cereal and milk for breakfast and a ham sandwich with fruit and milk for lunch. Ala Carte items may not be charged and are cash only unless a student has money available on their lunch account.

GISD offers a prepayment plan that can be accessed via the website and paid with a credit card or parents/students may pay by check or cash any time through the cafeteria. Students who pay their lunch balance in full will continue to enjoy charging privileges until the May 6 deadline.

GISD appreciates your cooperation and asks that all lunch accounts be paid in full by May 24.
